

Requested to lead a full design team through the planning, design, and entitlement process, Crestone

Consultants seized this opportunity, compiling a team of talented design and construction professionals to successfully re-zone, re-plat, and design this 90,000 sf commercial redevelopment in Pueblo, Colorado. The ingenuity, dedication, and collaborative spirit of Crestone, and the team, helped create a redevelopment plan which kept project development and construction costs in line with the projected business models and increased the expected rentable area by approximately 10%, maximizing the profit potential.



The Project

The National Storage USA project redeveloped approximately 5 acres of existing retail and mobile home lots



into a single commercial parcel which will be utilized for secured mini storage and retail businesses. This \$4.7 million development included obtaining approvals through the City of Pueblo - use by special review, commercial site plan, and subdivision plat processes. Additional approvals were granted through the Colorado Department of Transportation for obtaining access and utility permits.
